Topic: Writing a literature review, properly acknowledge sources and plagiarism

Outcomes

- students to get to know each other and their tutor
- understand how to write a review of literature and properly acknowledge reference sources you are using
- identify appropriate resources and find other resources

Activity

Your tutor will discuss with you again what plagiarism is and how to avoid you're your tutor will hand out two papers. Begin by introducing yourselves and in groups of two complete the following:

1. The tutor will hand out a paper, in pairs look at the examples the tutor has handed out and identify which of the different ways the research has been reported:
 - paraphrased (p)
 - author/s own research (R)
 - quotation (Q)

Mark the different sections of the paper to indicate which of the three ways the research has been reported. Pay particular attention to the literature section of the paper and discuss how that is structured, what is the author trying to achieve, how does it relate to the rest of the paper?

2. In pairs look at the list of references handed out. Mark those references you think would not be appropriate to use in a research paper.

3. Read the section of the paper that has been given to you. Look carefully at the text and consider the issue of plagiarism. Discuss with your partner what stands out about this work

Please ensure that you are familiar with the regulations relating to plagiarism. If you are caught plagiarising you will not be able to use as your defence that you were unaware as to what plagiarism was.
